Interested in having fresh, locally grown produce delivered to you right here at MMC? Registration for the Fresh Start Farms CSA begins Feb. 22 on the Cultivating Community website.

Fresh Start Farm's vegetables are grown locally in Lisbon, ME and are 100 percent chemical, pesticide and herbicide free. All of the produce is grown by immigrant and refugee farmers who are working to strengthen Maine's local food economy and build community. Each week of the CSA, you'll receive a variety of fresh vegetables and herbs, delivered right to various MMC locations throughout the greater Portland area. You may choose the 16-week, fullseason share and enjoy fresh vegetables from July through October, or an eight-week share for either summer or fall.

Fresh Start Farms offers sliding scale payment options and automatic installment plans. They also provide a 50 percent discount to anyone using EBT/ SNAP benefits.
