

Introduction

The MaineHealth Institute for Research (MHIR) Mentored Research Grant (MRG) Program was established ~2009 and currently allocates ~\$60,000 annually to promote and support clinical and translational research by early-career healthcare providers and scientists. This intramural grant program was created to encourage and support the intellectual curiosity and research capabilities of young early-stage investigators.

Details

- > Funding amounts are limited to \$10,000 for research studies
- Research studies should be projected to take 1 year to complete
- > This provides opportunity to support 6 investigators per year
- > Those eligible to seek funding include:
- ✓ MMC residents and fellow physicians
- ✓ MMC junior providers within 5 years of terminal degree
- ✓ MHIR post-doctoral fellows doing clinical research combined with translational and basic science components
- > The Maine Medical Center (MMC) Scientific Review Committee (SRC) reviews submitted MRG proposals on a quarterly basis
- Recommendations are made to MaineHealth Vice President of Research
- > Studies deemed 'human subjects' research would require IRB review and approval prior to being awarded
- > Proposals submitted after depletion of the funding pool will be deferred to the first cycle of the following year.



Note: The SRC Committee will review MRG proposals on the 1st Tuesday of February, May, **August and November.** Submission Deadlines are typically 2-3 weeks prior to the review date.

We hope that MRG grants financed by the MHIR will establish a pipeline for mentorship of early-career healthcare providers and scientists in addition to generating new knowledge that will be disseminated, via presentations and publications, to the broader medical, public health and scientific communities.
