Infection Prevention Week: Break the Chain of Infection

International Infection Prevention Week raises awareness of the role our Epidemiology and Infection Prevention (IP) team plays to improve patient safety.

IP responsibilities also include other areas of focus such as hand hygiene, disinfection/sterilization, surgical asepsis, patient hygiene device insertion practices,

Studies have found that investment in trained infection prevention nurses and doctors decreased infections by 40 percent, establishing the first hospital quality improvement program. Strong surveillance programs seek to prevent the spread of infection by collaborating with the front -line workers and leadership to continuously examine, evaluate, and act on identified Infection Prevention issues.
