## BBCH Receives Kohl's Grant to Raise Immunization Awareness

The Barbara Bush Children's Hospital (BBCH) at Maine Medical Center was recently awarded a nearly \$80,000 grant from Kohl's Cares to create and implement a social marketing campaign, Kohl's Vax Kids, in York and Cumberland counties. MaineHealth's Child Health Program will be managing the project and working with the MMC Centers for Outcomes Research and Evaluation

(CORE) to evaluate the approach and activities.

The Kohl's Vax Kids campaign aims to increase awareness about the necessity of childhood vaccination to maintain child health and motivate parents to discuss vaccination with their children's physician. The campaign will target parents of young children (age five and under), focusing on the necessity of vaccines and

addressing the use of alternative schedules, through both mass media and community-based strategies.

"Vaccine-preventable infections remain a serious threat to our children and our community. We appreciate the partnership between the Barbara Bush Children's Hospital and Kohl's Cares as we work to raise awareness about immunizations," said Dr. John Bancroft,

Chief of Pediatrics, Barbara Bush Children's Hospital at Maine Medical Center.

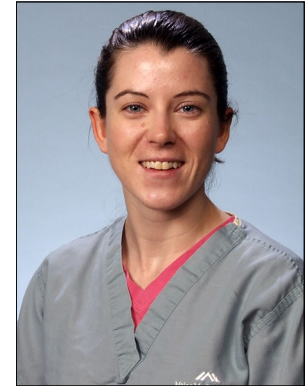
