Medical Center Boards of Trustees, MMC is moving forward with plans to build five state-of-the-art operating rooms on the Bean Building rooftop. With a price tag of \$40 million, some people are asking, "Why now?" Maine Medical Center leadership believes the reasons are simple and clear:

- Surgery is important to the health of our community as they look to us to provide a local option for advanced procedures.
- We need ample space and modern technology

- to perform complex, life -saving interventions. It means something entirely different to be "plugged in" today than it did almost 30 years ago.
- Our current ORs are overbooked by industry standards. New spaces increase our flexibility to deliver on both scheduled and emergent procedures. Operating at a more sustainable pace will generate greater revenue for MMC.
