Summer program provides job training

This summer Davine Vance, a disabled youth, is cleaning patient rooms and washing floors as part of the Summer Youth Training Program at Maine Medical Center. The program enables Davine and other youths like her, earn a paycheck while being trained the basic skills needed to secure a job in the future.

Youths ages 16-19 are selected from the special educational programs of local schools to participate in the program that's offered through MMC's Hospital Industries Program and the Training Resource Center in Portland. Youths, who have established acceptable levels of dependability and reliability, are placed in work sites throughout the hospital based

on the most appropriate job match.

Most of the work sites are in the areas of Food Services, Materiel Management, the Print Shop, and Housekeeping. Training and instruction are provided by the supervisors in each department. An evaluation is sent to each participating school following the work experience.

In addition to job training, the youths have the opportunity to attend workshops each week on topics such as career choices, job seeking skills, application skills, and banking basics. The workshops are designed to foster their communication skills in the workplace, overall work maturity and broaden their knowledge of vocational options and choices.

This summer nine youths are participating in the program, they are:

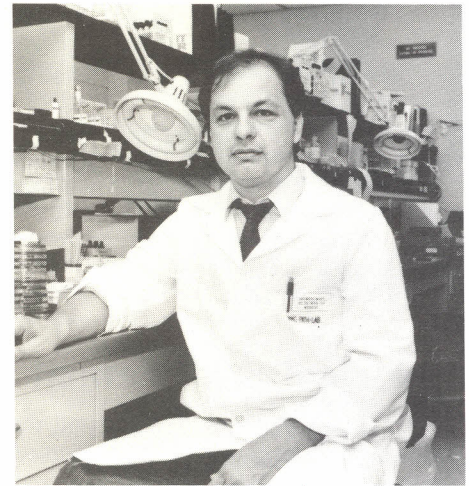
