

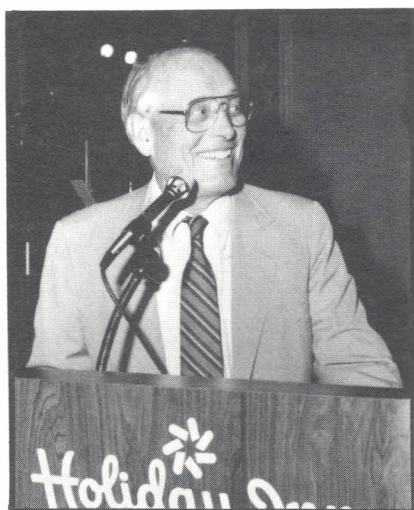

"Summer Sun-Not All Fun" will be shown on Channel 16, the Public Cable Station, Friday, June 24 at 8 PM, Saturday, June 25 at 2 PM and 8 PM, Sunday, June 26 at 2 PM and 8 PM, and Monday, June 27 at 2 PM and 8 PM.

The program will be a discussion of emergency medical problems caused by summer sun and heat; long term skin problems caused by sun exposure; how to avoid problems; and where to get help.

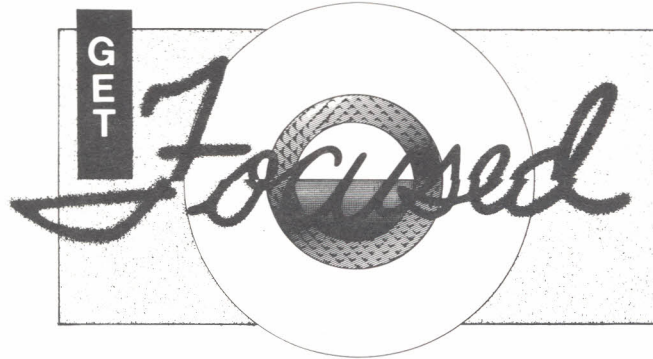
## About People

- 7. Entries must be submitted in person, and entrants must present their MMC ID.*
- 8. Entry deadline is Friday, July 22, 1988.*
- 9. Photos must be submitted to the Public Information office between 8.30 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.*
- 10. An entry blank must be completed and submitted with photo. Entry blanks can be picked up in the Public Information Office or can be found on poster displays.*
- 11. Photos will be judged by a panel of experts from the Greater Portland area.*
- 12. First, second, and third places will be awarded in each category by the judges.*
- 13. All photos will be mounted on black board and displayed in the lobby of the Dana Center during the day-time, Monday, August 8 - Friday, August 12, 1988. (Photos will be locked up at night).*
