## FOR A NEW LIBRARY

A donor, described only as a young physician and member of the MMC Medical Staff, has given \$1,000 to the hospital as "seed money" for a fund that he hopes eventually will make possible a new Health Science Library. In a letter accompanying his check, the anonymous donor envisioned the possible incorporation of a new library in a facility that will embrace medical research and medical education, with an auditorium and appropriate classroom and seminar room space. "A number of us," he said, "hope that this will become a top-priority item in the not-too-distant future." The donor suggested that his gift, with the interest it earns, might be the basis of a "New Health Science Library Fund" to which others might contribute.
