Flu Season Masking

All MMC colleagues are asked to help prevent the spread of disease by staying home when sick, using proper cough and sneeze etiquette, cleaning hands often and using a face mask if not vaccinated against influenza.

Proper Masking:

- Perform hand hygiene before placing and after removing mask.
- Place mask over your mouth and nose.
- Adjust the metal strip snugly over your nose bridge.
- Never hang around neck or place on top of head.
- Remove and discard after every patient.
